C. Athlete Eligibility

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY								
<p>All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, and only those athletes who comply with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Youth Olympic Games.</p> <p>Athletes who are born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 1999 are eligible to participate in the shooting events of the 2nd Summer Youth Olympic Games. Only eligible athletes can obtain Minimum Qualification Scores (MQS) results or quota places.</p> <p>MINIMUM QUALIFICATION SCORES (MQS)</p> <p>All athletes, including candidates for NOC Universality Places, must obtain a YOG MQS to be entered by their NOC in the shooting events of the Youth Olympic Games.</p> <p>MQS must be obtained in ISSF Championships or in ISSF designated competitions approved by the ISSF Executive Committee. MQS scores must be obtained between 1 April 2013 and 8 June 2014.</p> <p>YOG MQS for shooting are:</p> <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td style="width: 35%;">10m Air Rifle (AR) – 60 shots</td> <td style="width: 15%; text-align: center;">552</td> <td style="width: 35%;">10m Air Rifle (AR) – 40 shots</td> <td style="width: 15%; text-align: center;">368</td> </tr> <tr> <td>10m Air Pistol (AP) – 60 shots</td> <td style="text-align: center;">540</td> <td>10m Air Pistol (AP) – 40 shots</td> <td style="text-align: center;">355</td> </tr> </table> <p>GENERAL RULES FOR QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS</p> <p>YOG quota places must be earned in designated qualifying competitions that will take place between 1 April 2013 and 8 June 2014. Those competitions must consist of a qualification and a final round. D. Qualification System

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY																																																											
<p>For each qualifying event, the qualification places obtained for the Youth Olympic Games will be allocated to:</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Athletes</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> NOCs</p> <p>A total of 80 quota places in total will be distributed according to the following qualification procedure:</p> <p>One quota place is one starting position for the Youth Olympic Games. Continental Qualifying Competitions must have YOG qualifying events where all participating athletes are born in 1996, 1997, 1998 or 1999 (YOG Shooting Youth Category). Qualifying Competitions may take place during Continental Championships or in other specially designated competitions as proposed by the Continental Confederation and approved by the ISSF Executive Committee.</p> <p>IF quotas will be awarded according to the final ranking in each qualifying event in a Continental Qualifying Competition. HOST COUNTRY REPRESENTATION
<p>The host country will be directly qualified in two (2) events as follows, provided its selected athletes have obtained a YOG MQS:</p> <p>One (1) Quota Place in 10m Air Rifle Women</p> <p>One (1) Quota Place in 10m Air Pistol Men</p>

UNIVERSALITY PLACES
<p>To be eligible to receive Universality Places, athletes must comply with the eligibility criteria as defined under point C. of this document. 24 places will be allocated, pending that the technical level allows it.</p>

E. Confirmation process for quota places

CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUALIFICATION PLACES
<p>Each NOC selects the athletes to be entered in each YOG shooting event from its eligible athletes (born in 1996, 1997, 1998 or 1999 who have obtained a YOG MQS). Each NOC must decide on the use of its qualification places, in accordance with the following schedule:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ After a qualifying event, and immediately after the results of the doping tests are available, the ISSF will inform National Federations and NOCs concerning the qualification places they have obtained. ▪ Up to two (2) weeks after this notification, the NOCs must provide the ISSF with preliminary confirmation of their intention to use the qualification place(s). ▪ No later than 8 June 2014, provided that the last qualifying event finishes two weeks before, NOCs must confirm final acceptance of all obtained qualification places.

CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR HOST COUNTRY PLACES
<p>By 8 June 2014 the Host Country will confirm to ISSF the use of its allocated places.</p>

F. Reallocation of unused quota places

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES
<p>The ISSF will reallocate all remaining or returned unused qualification places by filling them with the next highest ranked eligible athletes from other NOCs in that event in the same Continental Qualifying Competition. If no redistribution is possible within the continent, the qualification place(s) will be reallocated to the NOC(s) with the largest number of MQS athletes which has/have not yet qualified for a quota place for the Nanjing YOG 2014.</p>

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES
<p>The ISSF will reallocate these quota places to the NOC(s) with the largest number of MQS athletes which has/have not yet qualified for a quota place for the Nanjing YOG 2014.</p>

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES
<p>Any unused Universality Places, including those returned after the final allocation by YOG Tripartite Commission, will be reallocated to the NOC(s) with the largest number of MQS athletes which has/have not yet qualified for a quota place for the Nanjing YOG 2014.</p>
